

Carl Davis is the research director at the Institute on Taxation and Economic Policy (ITEP). Carl works on a wide range of issues related to both state and federal tax policy. Particular areas of interest include tax incidence analysis, transportation funding, education tax preferences, and emerging issues such as the tax treatment of online shopping and the “gig economy.” He has advised policymakers and advocates on tax policy issues in nearly every state and his work is frequently cited in the media and by other researchers.

Prior to assuming the role of research director, Carl worked as an analyst for ITEP and used its proprietary microsimulation tax model to perform tax incidence and revenue analyses for lawmakers and advocates across the country. Carl also previously worked as part of the State Economic Issues team at AARP.
